



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

This heart envelope is designed to print on an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of paper.

- 1. Cut the heart out.
- 2. Fold the vertical lines inward
- 3. Fold on the horizontal dotted lines inward
- 4. The bottom of the heart becomes the top of the envelope.
